Stilettos on Steel

A sisterhood of motorcycle riders raised \$3,000 for Julie's Pink Warrior Project.



"Community building and giving back is really important to me and all the girls in our group," says Tammy R., Coordinator for the Beach Coast Chapter of Stilettos on Steel, an all-female motorcycle riding group "empowering women to ride safe, strong and street smart."

Thanks to the Stilettos' 2020 benefit ride, 30 underinsured or uninsured women will now receive free screening mammograms through the Julies's Pink Warrior Project.

Stilettos on Steel has close to 20 members in North Carolina, and is growing steadily, with new chapters coming soon to Charlotte and Raleigh. "We are bringing the midwest to the Carolinas," the Wisconsin native laughs." We have over 2,000 members across 16 states."

The mission is one of uniting female motorcyclists of all skill levels for friendship, support, and peer-to-peer or professional learning opportunities. "We are not a club!" Tammy stresses. "We are a diverse group of women from all walks of life that support and encourage each other." Under Tammy's watchful eye the only hard and fast rules are "Safety, number one, and no drama!"

Tammy has been riding all her adult life, and taught her 27-year-old daughter the rules of the road from an early age: safety, respect, and friendship.

Stilettos spans multiple decades from women in their 30's through 70's. Some are mothers, some are grandmothers, but all are sisters. As their Twitter account says [https://twitter.com/stilettosfrg], "Stilettos are just long lost sisters that found each other through their shared love of motorcycling."

What the women learn on the bikes often carries over to many areas of their lives. "You're not sitting on the back [of the bike] anymore, you're actually sitting in the driver's seat, so now you're in control," Tammy says. That feeling of empowerment has been enough for many women to make brave, positive changes in other areas of their lives, encouraged and supported by their Stilettos on Steel sisters


